



# CRIME BLOTTER: 07/17/16 – 07/23/16

## 07-18-16

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between 6:05pm & 8:50pm, in the 6400 block of Oak Avenue. Someone entered a locked residence and stole property. There was no sign of forced entry.

## 07-19-16

- A **Grand Theft** occurred at 5:20pm, at Temple City Boulevard & Woodruff Avenue. The victim entered her car and placed her purse on the front passenger seat. She rolled the front passenger window down and the suspect, who had walked up to her passenger door, grabbed her purse. The suspect ran to a car driven by a second suspect and fled.

- A **Residential Burglary** arrest of a MW/31 was made at 1:30pm, in the 5400 block of Rowland Avenue. The suspect lived at the location, broke into a locked room and stole property.
