

WHAT IS THE RECREATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM?

Recreation promotes physical, mental and social well-being for our youth. The City of Temple City Recreation Scholarship Program is designed to help children in families with limited financial resources participate in recreation programs and activities offered through the Department of Parks and Recreation. The program is funded through the Community Development Block Grant Program. Recreation Scholarship Program recipients receive a 50% or 75% discount (not including non-refundable administrative fee). Applicants family/household income must meet the CDBG low-income to extremely-low income guidelines to qualify.

DO YOU QUALIFY?

To qualify for a scholarship discount, age, residency and income requirements must be met.

Age Requirement - participants must be 17 years or younger

Residency Requirement - participants must live in an approved city.

Income Requirements - participants must live in a household that fits within the guidelines listed in the chart.

HOW TO APPLY

Complete the Recreation Scholarship Program application and attach all **required** documentation.

*Proof of residency (copy of driver’s license /CA ID and utility bill for each adult living at the residence)

*Proof of income (3 current paystubs for each employed adult & previous year’s income tax return)

Incomplete applications will be mailed back unprocessed. Applicant will be notified by mail if the application was approved. Please allow up to 5 days for processing.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS -

- **DO I NEED TO BE A RESIDENT OF TEMPLE CITY TO APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP?** No, but you must be a resident of one of the following cities to apply: Arcadia, Bradbury, Claremont, Covina, Duarte, Glendora, La Canada-Flintridge, La Verne, Monrovia, San Dimas, San Gabriel, San Marino, Sierra Madre or South Pasadena.
- **WHEN CAN I APPLY?** Applications are accepted throughout the year, however an application is approved for a fiscal year (July 1—June 30 of the following year).
- **IF APPROVED, AM I GUARANTEED A DISCOUNT?** No, Recreation Scholarship Program scholarships are awarded on a first-come basis and are awarded provided funds are available. Applicants will be notified by mail of program eligibility after their application has been processed.
- **WHO CAN APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP?** A parent or legal guardian completes the application and is responsible for providing accurate information and proper documentation. We ask for income documentation to determine if the family needs the CDBC federal income limits.
- **DOES THE SCHOLARSHIP EXPIRE?** Yes. You will need to re-apply to be considered for discount each fiscal year, completing a new application with current proof of residency and income.
- **CAN I USE THE DISCOUNT PRIOR TO BEING APPROVED?** No, applicants must be approved prior to program registration to receive the discount.
- **WHAT IS CONSIDERED HOUSEHOLD INCOME?** Household monthly gross income includes income from wages/unemployment benefits, child or spousal support, CAL FRESH, CASH AID, Social Security/Disability benefits and self-employment for each adult living at the residence.
