

ARBOR DAY POSTER & VIDEO CONTEST

POSTER CONTEST RULES:

OPEN TO GRADES K-8

- All entries must be original artwork created by a student who is currently in third, fourth, or fifth grade.
- The student's first and last name must be written or signed in the lower right-hand corner on the front of the poster.
- Entries may be done in marker, crayon, paint pens, watercolor, ink, acrylic, colored pencil, and/or tempera paint. Collages, glue, computer- or photo-generated art, and printing are NOT acceptable.
- Entries must be no smaller than 8.5"x11" and no larger than 14"x18".
- Entries must be done on paper that will allow for duplication, display, and framing. Entries should NOT be matted, mounted, laminated, framed, or folded.
- The poster must be related to the contest theme in some way. The theme **Trees Are Superheroes!** must appear somewhere on the poster.
- Submit entries to Live Oak Park Annex by Tuesday, February 7, 2017.
- *Entries not meeting the contest rules will be disqualified.*

VIDEO CONTEST RULES:

OPEN TO GRADES 6-8

- All entries must be original videos created by a student who is currently in sixth, seventh, or eighth grade.
- The file name must include your first and last name. Example: JohnSmithVideoContest.mov
- Each student can submit one entry.
- Entries should be no longer than 30 seconds.
- Entries should not contain any names, logos, brands or music.
- The video must be related to the contest theme in some way. The theme **Trees Are Superheroes!** must appear at some point in the video.
- Submit entries to Live Oak Park Annex by Tuesday, February 7, 2017.
- Entries must be in one of the following digital video formats: AVI, MOV, MPG, or WMV

A citywide winner will be chosen for each grade level. The winning entries will be submitted to the State contest, where they will then choose the winner for each grade level. All entries will be displayed at Temple City's Arbor Day Celebration event on Wednesday, March 8, 2017, from 2:00 p.m.—5:00 p.m. at Live Oak Park.

CONTEST PRIZE

The student that wins the Statewide contest will receive the following:

- A \$100 check (mailed to their home)
- A printed copy of their design (Poster only)
- An award certificate
