

CITY OF TEMPLE CITY CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of February 16, 2021. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the regular meeting of February 16, 2021, the City Council:

- Recognized and congratulated the 2021 Camellia Festival Royal Court;
- Approved Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of February 2, 2021;
- Received and filed the Regular Parks and Recreation Commission meeting action of January 20, 2021;
- Authorized the City Manager to enter into a second amendment to the agreement with Harris & Associates for the Lighting and Landscape District assessment services;
- Approved the Facility Use Agreement with the Herald Christian Health Center to operate a COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic at Live Oak Park and authorized the City Manager to execute the agreement;
- Received and filed the Visa Card Report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 21-5513 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2020-21;
- Approved the Third Amendment to the Amended and Restated Agreement with Athens Services to collect solid waste, recyclables, and yard waste to comply with State law and mandates and found that the Third Amendment to the Amended and Restated Agreement with Athens Services is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") under California Code of Regulation Section 15308, which exempts "actions by regulatory agencies for protection of the environment." This Third Amendment is consistent with the goals of California State Assembly Bills 939, 341, and 1826, and Senate Bill 1381;
- Introduced and waived further reading of Ordinance No. 21-1053, repealing Title 6, Chapter 2, Article C – “Garbage and Rubbish Disposal” and Title 6, Chapter 2, Article D – “Integrated Waste Management Program” of the Temple City Municipal Code and adding Title 6, Chapter 2, Article C – “Solid Waste Management” to the Temple City Municipal Code and approved the typographic errors in the ordinance;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager;
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
