

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY
CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meetings of October 19, 2021. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the Special Meeting on October 19, 2021, the City Council:

- Recessed to Closed Session regarding Conference with Labor Negotiator, Temple City Employee Association, Unrepresented General, Part-Time Employees. There is no reportable action.

At the Regular meeting of October 19, 2021, the City Council:

- Approved the Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of September 29, 2021;
- Approved the Minutes of the Special and Regular City Council Meeting of October 5, 2021;
- Received and filed the actions of the Planning Commission Regular Meeting of September 28, 2021;
- Accepted project completion for the Las Tunas Drive Pavement Rehabilitation, Phase 2, from Sultana Avenue to East City Limit, CIP No. P20-07 as performed by All American Asphalt for a total amount of \$901,435.36; authorized the City Manager to file a project Notice of Completion with the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder; and authorized the City Manager to release a retention payment of \$45,071.77 to All American Asphalt within 35 days following recordation of the Notice of Completion;
- Reviewed and approved the Design Professional Services Agreement (Attachment "A") with Onyx Architects. This agreement is based on a term of five years (with an initial three-year term and an automatic renewal for up to two more years), and an annual budget not to exceed \$20,000 with a total not to exceed \$100,000; and authorized the City Manager to execute the agreement with Onyx Architects;
- Adopted Ordinance No. 21-1057, amending Title 2, Chapter 6, Article C, Section 5 of the Temple City Municipal Code regarding the Art in Public Places Program;
- Adopted Resolution No. 21-5563 authorizing the execution of a Reimbursable Contract with the County of Los Angeles in order to receive Permanent Local Housing Allocation funds;
- Received and filed the Visa Card Report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 21-5561 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2021-22;
- Adopted Resolution No. 21-5562 to allow City Council to continue the use of teleconferencing or videoconferencing for Brown Act-covered public meetings of the City Council and City commissions for a period of 30 days;
- Discussed the proposed program relating to 72 hour parking restriction exemption and provided no further direction;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager; and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
