

CITY OF TEMPLE CITY CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of May 3, 2022. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meetings. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meetings.

At the Regular meeting of May 3, 2022, the City Council:

- Declared May Older American Month;
- Received an update on the City's Farmers Market;
- Approved the Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of April 19, 2022;
- Continued the adoption of Resolution No. 22-5591 confirming Mayor's appointment of Councilmembers to serve as delegates and alternates to other agencies or organizations to a future meeting;
- Received and filed the actions of the Parks and Recreation Commission Regular Meeting of April 20, 2022;
- Approved the nine applications for fireworks permits for the 2022 season (Faith UMC of the SGV, Temple City Aquatics Foundation, Temple City Amateur Softball Association, Temple City Grad Nite, Temple City High School Band, Temple City Emmanuel Church, Temple City Ramrodders, Temple City American Little League);
- Ratified and approved the installation of red curb adjacent to the north side of the driveway at 5729 Temple City Boulevard;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5592 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2021-22;
- Introduced for first reading by title only and waived further reading of Ordinance No. 22-1060, Series B Code Amendments of Title 9 (Zoning Regulations), Chapter 1 (Zoning Code) and scheduled the second reading of the ordinance for May 17, 2022;
- Introduced for first reading by title only and waived further reading of Ordinance No. 22-1061, amending Title 4 ("Law Enforcement"), Chapter 2 ("Nuisances") of the Temple City Municipal Code to provide for regulations pertaining to the maintenance and landscaping of vacant properties and scheduled the second reading of the ordinance for May 17, 2022;
- Continued the review of Council Ad Hoc and Standing Committees item to a future meeting;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager; and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
