

CITY OF TEMPLE CITY CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meetings of June 21, 2022. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meetings. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meetings.

At the Special meeting of June 21, 2022, the City Council:

- Met in Closed Session for Conference with Labor Negotiator. There is no reportable action; and
- Met in Closed Session for Conference with Legal Counsel regarding an anticipated litigation. There is no reportable action.

At the Regular meeting of June 21, 2022, the City Council:

- Approved the Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of June 8, 2022;
- Approved the Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of June 8, 2022;
- Received and filed the actions of the Planning Commission Regular Meeting of May 24, 2022;
- Received and filed the actions of the Transportation and Public Safety Commission Regular Meeting of February 23, April 13, and June 8, 2022;
- Approved a one year professional service agreement with the Temple City Chamber of Commerce;
- Awarded a five year lease agreement to Ricoh for copy machines;
- Affirmed City's participation with the San Gabriel Valley Council of Governments and commitment to develop certain deliverables with the goal of adopting an Inclusionary Housing Ordinance;
- Adopted Ordinance No. 22-1063 changing the reference number of Ordinance No. 22-1060 for Campaign Contribution Limits to Ordinance No. 22-1063;
- Approved plans and authorization to invite bids for Fiscal Year 2021-22 Pavement Rehabilitation Project, Capital Improvement Project (CIP No. P19-07);
- Approved the first amendment to the agreement with Southland Transit, Inc. for transportation services;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5601 adopting the Statement of Investment Policy for Fiscal Year 2022-23;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5605 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2021-22;
- Directed staff to get feedback from the downtown businesses regarding their employee parking needs and for staff to evaluate parking time limits in the city public parking lots for potentially adjusting the time limits to address the commercial employee parking needs;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5603 approving the Master Fees and Fines Schedule for Fiscal Year 2022-23;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5602 adopting the annual appropriation limit for Fiscal Year 2022-23;
- Adopted Resolution No. 22-5604 adopting the City Budget and approving appropriations for the City for Temple City for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager; and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
