

## CITY OF TEMPLE CITY CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of March 21, 2023. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the Special meeting of March 21, 2023, the City Council:

- Met in Closed Session regarding “Potential Litigation”. There is no reportable action; and
- Met in Closed Session regarding “Significant Exposure to Litigation, Facts Unknown to the Plaintiff”. There is no reportable action.

At the Regular meeting of March 21, 2023, the City Council:

- Approved the City Council Regular Meeting Minutes of March 7, 2023 and found that the City Council Minutes is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guideline 15061(b)(3);
- Adopted Resolution No. 23-5661 confirming Mayor’s appointment of Councilmembers to serve as delegates and alternates to other agencies or organizations and found that the appointments are exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guideline 15061(b)(3);
- Received the 2022 General Plan Annual Progress Report and found that the annual report is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15306 (Information Collection) of the California CEQA Guidelines, and approved the annual report and directed staff to file the annual report with the Office of Planning and Research and the Department of Housing and Community Development;
- Received and filed the Visa Card Report and found that receiving and filing of the report is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) per Section 15061(b)(3);
- Adopted Resolution No. 23-5660 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2022-23 and found that approving the payment of bills is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guideline 15061(b)(3);
- Approved the service agreement with Flock Group Inc. for 10 automated license plate reader camera subscriptions in the amount of \$28,500 for the first year and \$25,500 for the second year;
- Received the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Mid-Year Financial Review and related reports and found that the financial review and related reports are not a “Project” as defined under Section 15378 of the California Environmental Quality Act State Guidelines; therefore, pursuant to State Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3) no environmental review is required;
- Established the City Commissioner Recruitment Ad Hoc Committee and appointed Mayor Pro Tem Chavez and Councilmember Vizcarra to the committee;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager;
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
