

CITY OF TEMPLE CITY CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of June 6, 2023. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the Special meeting of June 6, 2023, the City Council:

- Met to discuss one item of potential litigation. There is no reportable action; and
- Tabled the discussion with the City's labor negotiators regarding current negotiation with Temple City Employee Association which also affects the Unrepresented General, and Part-Time Employees. There is no reportable action.

At the Regular meeting of June 6, 2023, the City Council:

- Received and filed the City Council Special Meeting Minutes of May 16, 2023, May 23, 2023, and Regular Meeting Minutes of May 16, 2023;
- Received and filed the Transportation and Public Safety Commission Actions of May 10, 2023;
- Adopted resolutions confirming appointments to the Parks and Recreation Commission, Planning Commission, and Transportation and Public Safety Commission;
- Adopted Ordinance No. 23-1071 amending Section 9-1T-21 (Urban dwellings and urban lot splits) of the Municipal Code related to SB-9;
- Approved the agreement with San Gabriel Valley Humane Society for animal control, shelter, and licensing services;
- Adopted Resolution No. 23-5672 to approve the Road Repair and Accountability Act (SB 1) project list for Fiscal Year 2023-2024;
- Approved amendment two to the agreement with the San Gabriel Valley Council of Governments for preparing and maintaining the San Gabriel Valley Regional vehicle miles traveled (VMT) Analysis Model;
- Authorized receiving of the California Automated Permit Processing Grant and entered into an agreement with the California Energy Commission;
- Approved the annual rate adjustment of 4.65% requested by Athens Services for solid waste collection services to become effective July 1, 2023;
- Approve a Memorandum of Agreement between the members of the Upper Los Angeles River Watershed Group and the San Gabriel Valley Council of Governments regarding the administration and cost sharing for implementing the Watershed Management Plan associated tasks and the Coordinated Integrated Monitoring Program for the Upper Los Angeles River Watershed Management Area, and authorized the City Manager to sign the Memorandum of Agreement;
- Approved an agreement with Transtech Engineers, Inc. to provide building and safety services and public works engineering services, and authorized the City Manager to execute the Agreement;
- Received and filed the Annual Comprehensive Financial Report for the year ended June 30, 2022, received and filed the Independent Auditor's Communication to the City, received and filed the Independent Accountants' Report on Applying Agreed Upon Procedures related to the Article XIII-B Appropriations Limit Calculation, and received and filed the Independent Auditor's Report on International Control over Financial Reporting and on Compliance and Other Matter based on an audit of Financial Statements performed in accordance with Government Auditing Standards;
- Approved hosting and co-sponsorship of a 2023 Hi Autumn Festival (Festival) with World Journal LA, LLC (World Journal) on Saturday, September 16 through Sunday, September 17, 2023;

- Received and filed the Visa Card Report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 23-5674 authorizing the payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2022-23;
- Adopted Resolution No. 23-5671 ordering the levy and collection of Citywide Lighting and Maintenance District assessments for Fiscal Year 2023-2024;
- Provided staff direction on the proposed City Budget for Fiscal Year 2023-24;
- Reviewed the justification for the addition of three-section flashing yellow arrow protected/permissive left turn phasing at the intersection of Baldwin Avenue and Live Oak Avenue and directed staff to forward the traffic engineer's recommendation to California Joint Power Insurance Authority for liability review and feedback;
- Disbanded the City Commissioner Recruitment Ad Hoc Committee;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager; and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
