

CITY OF TEMPLE CITY CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of November 7, 2023. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the Special meeting of November 7, 2023, the City Council:

- Met in Closed Session regarding “Conference with Real Property Negotiator” for property at 5003 Sereno Drive, Temple City. City Council gave unanimous direction to the City Manager to cancel escrow if the seller fails to perform the seller’s duties as of the due date for close of escrow and to pursue such other actions or remedies as the city would need in order to close the pending code enforcement case on the property.

At the Regular meeting of November 7, 2023, the City Council:

- Approved the City Council Regular Meeting Minutes of October 17, 2023 and Special Meeting of October 25, 2023;
- Received and filed the Planning Commission regular meeting actions of September 26, 2023;
- Received and filed the Transportation and Public Safety Commission regular meeting actions of September 13, and October 11, 2023;
- Authorized City Manager to sign a Letter of Authorization to allow the San Gabriel Valley Council of Governments (SGVCOG) to apply for the CalRecycle 1383 Local Assistance Grant Program on behalf of the City;
- Approved the Maser Agreement with the Temple City Camellia Festival (TCCF) and authorized the City Manager to sign the Agreement;
- Approved the temporary lane closures on Las Tunas Drive between Muscatel Avenue and Rosemead Boulevard on December 16, 2023, from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. for the Temple Station Mug Run;
- Received and filed the Visa Card Report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 23-5709 authorizing the payment of bills for fiscal year 2023-24;
- Authorized the City Manager to execute a third amendment to the agreement with United Maintenance Systems, Inc. (UMS) for Citywide Janitorial Services;
- Authorized the City Manager to execute a third amendment to the agreement with West Coast Arborist, Inc. (WCA) for tree maintenance services;
- Received and filed the Petty Cash Report;
- Reviewed calendar of upcoming regularly scheduled City Council meetings and considered canceling regular meetings that land on the week of certain holidays and adopted Resolution No. 23-5710 canceling the City Council meetings on January 2, 2024, July 2, 2024, and December 17, 2024;

- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager; and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
